eChapters – Did you know?

eChapters are electronic files of the first few chapters of the textbook.

- Students may purchase eChapters for \$5 with the purchase of a printed textbook
- eChapters offer students immediate access to the first few chapters of their textbooks while they are waiting for the print book to arrive
- eChapters help students keep up with required reading and assignments until they receive their course material, without having to pay expedited shipping costs.
